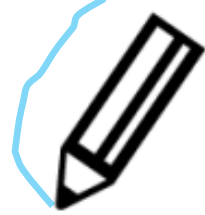


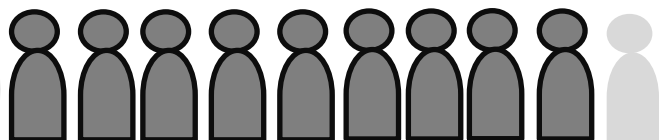
# 10,272 students

in Grades 7-12 participated in CAMH's 2013 Ontario Student Drug Use & Health Survey (OSDUHS). Here are some highlights from the Mental Health and Well-Being and Drug Use reports that address the school setting:

## Spotlight on Schools



### Attitudes about School:



**9 in 10 FEEL CLOSE** to people at school and **FEEL THEY ARE PART** of their school.



**1 in 4** spend **LESS THAN ONE HOUR** on homework per week.

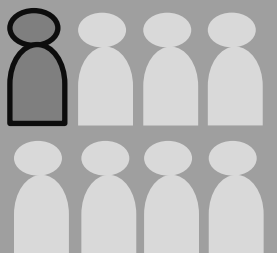
### Drugs at School:



**1 in 4** believe drug use is a **BIG PROBLEM** in their school.



**1 in 5** have been offered, sold, or given a **DRUG AT SCHOOL** in the past year.

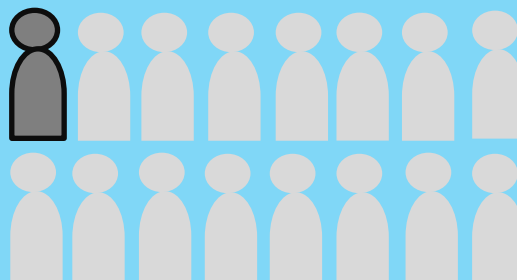


**1 in 8** were **INTOXICATED AT SCHOOL** at least once in the past year.

### School Safety:



**1 in 6** are worried about being **HARMED**, threatened or robbed at school.



**1 in 16** were **THREATENED** or **INJURED** with a weapon at school at least once in the past year.

### Bullying at School:



**1 in 4** were **BULLIED** at school and the most common form of bullying is verbal.



**1 in 6** **BULLIED OTHER STUDENTS** at school.

## Some improving trends...

- ✓ **1 in 10** were involved in a physical fight on school property – a significant decline since 1999.
- ✓ Bullying at school has declined during the past decade.
- ✓ Almost half of students like school very much or quite a lot – an increase since 1999.
